Sanam is a 30-year-old single mother with a five-year-old son. Simon, her husband, denied Christ and became a Muslim because Islam allows him to keep four wives at a time; he is married to three different women. He abused and abandoned his Christian wife while she was pregnant. She works the lowest-paying job of \$50 a month, which is insufficient for a one-room monthly rent. House of Mercy is Committed to loving them as Christ loved.



Razia is a widow with four children: a 16-year-old boy, a 13-year-old girl, an 11-year-old boy, and a 7-year-old girl. Her husband was a Rickshaw (taxi) driver, and they were a happy family. One day, five years ago, her husband suddenly had a heart attack and died. She was a housewife while her husband provided all the needs of the family. Since she was uneducated, she started working as a cleaner and was paid \$75 a month, which was insufficient to pay her house rent, food, and children's education. House of Mercy is Committed to loving them as Christ loved.



Nadia is a single mother with two children, Davis, a 5-year-old boy, and Lidiya, a 4-year-old girl. Her husband is a drug addict who sold all his household belongings for drugs, abused, and abandoned them. They were homeless and without food and shelter. House of Mercy is taking care of all the needs of this single mother and her two children, such as school, clothing, food, and shelter.



Javed and Sana and their twin boys. Javed works at a store and makes \$100 a month. Her wife is suffering from Chronic Joint Disease and is mostly in bed. Her husband pays \$50 a month for her medication. After paying for medication, this family is left with \$50, which is not enough to pay for their house rent, food, and children's education. Javed is also a student at Pakistan School of the Word, where he is being trained to become a Pastor. House of Mercy is providing for all the needs of this family.
